New benefits of MY Denver Card

In October, Denver Mayor Michael B. Hancock announced that new benefits will be available when families sign up for or renew their [MY Denver Card](#). The card provides free, year-round access to Denver's 27 recreation centers and 29 pools, plus serves as a library card, to Denver children ages 5 to 18.

Nine arts, culture and science organizations are now participating in the nationally recognized program, providing Denver kids with a wide range of options for free admission or discounted tickets.
